Plan is worth one mark.

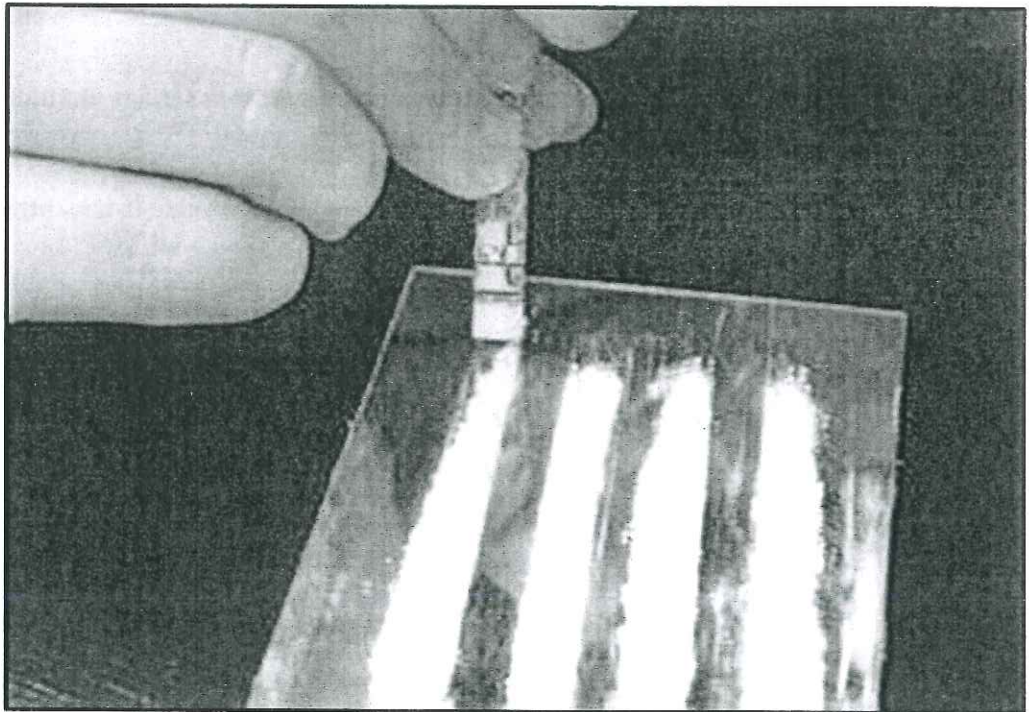

- Or (d)** Recently, your brother assisted the Police to catch a drug dealer who had been selling in the neighbourhood.
