

## Lecon 4 – First group verbs – part 2

Recap:

In French, Verbs that finish with the letters “...-er” are considered to belong to the first group of verbs. The first group of verbs is the biggest and easiest group of verbs in the french language as most verbs are of this group, such as : s’appeler, manger, écouter, parler, danser, respirer, ... (to name, to eat, to listen, to speak, to dance, to breath, ...).

It is also, as stated above, the easiest of groups because the way to form is regular, and goes as such:

Verb in -er

Je –e

Tu –es

Il –e

Elle –e

Nous –ons

Vous –ez

Ils –ent

Elles –ent

So, in order to form the verbs, you need to take away the –er and replace it accordingly.

Example : ‘Manger’ becomes “Je mange, tu manges, il mange, elle mange, nous mangons, vous mangez, ils mangent and elles mangent”.
