Recap:

In French, Verbs that finish with the letters "...-er" are considered to belong to the <u>first group</u> of verbs. The first group of verbs is the biggest and easiest group of verbs in the french language as <u>most verbs</u> are of this group, such as: s'appeler, manger, ecouter, parler, danser, repirer, ... (to name, to eat, to listen, to speak, to dance, to breath, ...).

It is also, as stated above, the easiest of groups because the way to form is <u>regular</u>, and goes as such: Verb in –er

Je –e Tu –es II –e Elle –e Nous –ons

Vous –ez

Ils –ent

Elles -ent

So, in order to form the verbs, you need to take away the -er and replace it accodingly.

Example: 'Manger' becomes "Je mange, tu manges, il mange, elle mange, nous mangons, vous mangez, ils mangent and elles mangent".
