Je veux – I want

Tu veux – You want

Il veut – He wants

Elle veut – She wants

Nous voulons – We want

Vous voulez – You people want

Ils veulent – They boys want

Elles veulent – They girls want

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**Lesson 30 - the verb VENIR (to come)**

Je viens – I come

Tu viens – you come

Il vient – He comes

Elle vient – She comes

Nous venons – We come

Vous venez – You people come

Ils viennent – They boys come

Elles viennent – they girls come

Fact : The verb VENIR is from the third group because it is irregular. Another verb from that group is the verb FAIRE (to do).
